Rain Barrel Workshop – April 6th at 10:00 am at Selby Shelter House

If interested, the registration form is located on page 3 or visit GreenSpotRainBarrels.org to register online. The fee for the workshop and rain barrel is \$55. Please arrive 15 minutes early for the workshop. The barrel is a 45 gallon sealed system to keep out pests and comes with all parts for easy installation.

Neighbors are also invited to bring seeds to swap or donate during/after the event. This could include purchased seed packets you didn't use, bulk seed, or loose seed you collect from your garden. FCSWCD is starting us off with a donation of seeds they'll give away! Bring seed in a jar or other lidded container, or in original packaging. A handout with growing instructions would be great, too. CHCA will provide takehome bags, labels and markers.

National Register of Historic Places District Information Session March 12th, 8:30 pm

Following the next CHCA meeting there will be a brief information session held at Selby Shelter House regarding possible Historic District Nomination Coordination for Colonial Hills. In 2012 our neighborhood was the focus of an OSU city and regional planning course and a great deal of information was gathered regarding the history of Colonial Hills. It is possible that our neighborhood is eligible to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Colonial Hills could be the third National Register Listed Historic District in Worthington if this effort is successful! We're seeking to determine if residents are interested in learning more.

It is our understanding that because Colonial Hills is not subject to Worthington's Architectural Review Board, a National Register listing would **NOT** prevent property owners from altering their homes, and would not impose any additional financial or aesthetic requirements on homeowners.

A first step in the process would be submitting a completed questionnaire to The OHPO (Ohio State Preservation Office) to get concurrence from OHPO before proceeding with a nomination.



Patricia ("Pat") R. Weston, 436 S. Selby, age 78, passed on December 14, at her home. Pat was preceded in death by her husband Robert ("Bob") E. Weston, who died in 1992. The Westons were long-time Colonial Hills residents, having bought their home in July, 1963. Pat was particularly active in the Colonial Hills Civic Association, volunteering for the 4th of July celebration and other activities, and continued to volunteer into her golden years until her health prevented her.

Pat maintained many good friendships, and was very well-liked by her neighbors. She regaled friends and neighbors with her wonderfully interesting stories of life in Colonial Hills and Worthington in the 60's, 70's, and 80's, and of her life growing up as a coal miner's daughter in Kentucky, where she was a schoolmate of Loretta Lynn. Pat always seemed quite proud of her roots.

Pat also took great pride in her immaculately maintained yard and home, and in her later years, delighted in viewing the parade of life from her easy chair looking out her front window.

Pat is survived by her brothers, James Coleman and Ronald Coleman, her sister, Ernestine Webb, and by many nieces and nephews.




