Congratulations to the winner of the 2007 Colonial Hills Civic Association scholarship! Emily Adams was selected as the winner. Emily plans to attend Wittenberg University in the fall and major in Special Education. She has played softball, basketball and volleyball at school, as well as being a tutor. Emily is also in the youth group at Worthington United Methodist Church, and has attended the church's summer work camps.

Will Norman is graduating from Thomas Worthington High School. He will be attending OSU and will study business. Will has been a resident of Colonial Hills since 1997.

Eamon O'Brien will be graduating from Thomas Worthington High School. He will be attending the University of Cincinnati where he will study engineering.

The criteria to qualify for the scholarship include being a resident of the area, contributing 10 hours of service to the Colonial Hills Civic Association activities and attending one civic association meeting. The awards in the past have been for either \$750 or \$800. If you calculate the potential value of the hours worked, this would come out to be about \$65 or 70 per hour, tax free. The Civic Association needs help for the run and other activities at the July 4th celebration. The entry fees from the run go into the general fund, which is partially used for the award money. Students who wish to help can get a form to give to the event sponsor to record the hours donated from any officer or from myself. Other events that we need volunteers for include delivery of the Courier, the Easter egg hunt, and the Halloween party. So there are plenty of opportunities to get the required hours of service.
