



- outside the limits of the City of Columbus located inside Franklin County, but
  - have a minimum of \$15,000 available owner-occupied for at least one year
- current on Franklin County property taxes equity
- have homeowner's insurance
- home value cannot exceed \$160,000 (as valued by the Franklin County Auditor)
- cannot be on a land contract
- cannot be a mobile home or condominium
  - household income must be within the the homeowner's annual, pre-tax, following guidelines:

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## **GETTING RID OF RATS**



### Who's winning the RAT RACE in your neighborhood?

Follow these tips to help prevent or eliminate rats in your area.

### WHERE CAN RATS LIVE?

Rats can live in a variety of places including...

- Piles of debris, yard waste, lumber and abandoned cars
- Old garages and under patios and decks
- Junk furniture
- Dark, enclosed spaces such as between walls
- Holes in a building's foundation

### WHAT DO RATS EAT?

Rats eat quite a few surprising items such as...

- Garbage
- Food waste in compost piles
- Bird food on the ground
- Dog manure
- Any uneaten dog food left outside
- Fruit from trees

### WHAT CAN I DO TO RAT-PROOF MY HOME?

### Secure Garbage

- Make sure no garbage is outside the trash container on the ground
- Have strong cans with tight fitting lids
- Keep lids on tight at all times
- Make sure garbage is hauled away every week
- Put cans out for collection the night before or morning of your scheduled pickup
- Report damaged trash cans that are not the property of private residents to the appropriate authority

### Keep Your Yard Cleaned Up

- · Have junk cars hauled away
- Secure abandoned buildings
- Stack building materials, lumber and fire wood at least 18 inches off the ground
- Clean up dog manure daily

### If All Else Fails...

- Traps: Use traps made especially for rats, not mice.
- Poison: Rat poison can be bought at groceries and hardware stores; but read the label first!
- Exterminate: Property owners need to arrange extermination with a professional.

### **Cover Openings**

- All openings ½ inch or larger are possible rat entryways. Repair openings with concrete, sheet metal, or hardware cloth. Materials can be purchased at a hardware store. Use hardware cloth to screen basement windows and other windows that are within three feet of the ground.
- Basement drains with openings less than ½ inch in diameter can be covered with hardware cloth or a drain cover.
- Patch holes around wires and pipes. Seal with sheet metal or concrete patching.
- To keep rats from gnawing under and around doors, doors can be cuffed and channeled (consult with professionals for advice). Doors should not be more than 3/8 inch from the frame.
- Basement windows should fit tightly and have no broken panes.
- Rats live in dark, enclosed spots where regular

cleaning may be
difficult such as
between walls, in crawl
spaces, under porches
or patio floors, in
boxed-in plumbing, etc.
These dead spaces can
be permanently
sealed to prevent
creating a rat
harborage.

## Quick Tips for... RAT PROOFING

- Close doors
- Fix broken windows
- Cover holes in doors
- Patch cracks in foundations and walls
- Cover drains
- Screen air vents




